I just water the plants twice a day and

fertilize them once every few days. Sometimes, when a squirrel messes up the plant pots, I clean them and support the plants to help them to stand up well again. Then I just watch them grow and wait for the time to bear their fruits. I want them to be healthy and to grow up well and fast, but that is what I cannot fully control. What I can do here is to watch their growth carefully and help them to grow until they bear fruit.



Planting those vegetables, I contemplate how God works for us. Isn't God the same with us who are gardening? I believe that God has the same heart with us in gardening. As we plant the seeds, take care of them, help them to grow well and wait for them to bear their fruits, God also creates us, takes care of us, helps us, and waits for us to be the person who fully realizes God's will in the world. So, God is the farmer, and we are God's plants. Sometimes, the Sunshine is so strong; the wind is rough; there is a drought; there is an epidemic. But the farmer takes care of them. We also have some problems in our life. Our reality is that there are things we can handle, but there are many things we cannot handle. But we have a God that we can rely on. God watches us and waits for us to grow up well. And God helps and supports us when we are in trouble as the farmer does. This is because God loves us. It is the heart of God we can understand through the farmer and the plants. I hope we can all stand strong in the world, knowing that we are in God's care. Amen.

FROM THE LAYLEADER

I have been attending many webinars and listening to Bishop Bickerton and Rev. Doris Dalton about the cooperative parish. We are part of the Shoreline-Havens Parish which includes Branford UMC, Clinton UMC, Faith UMC (North Haven), First & Summerfield (New Haven), First & Wesley UMC, Hamden Plains UMC, St. Andrew's UMC (New Haven) and Westville UMC (New Haven).

The important thing to do right now in order to organize to start doing some ministries together is to build relationships. We are planning some getting-to-know-each-other activities.

At the "Day With the Bishop", the Bishop Bickerton talked about the need, more than ever, to be in cooperative ministry with other churches. Last year, the NYAC was short by 40 ministers to fill appointments. That has increased to 60.

Back when John Wesley started the Methodist Church in this country, we had circuit riders – ministers who would go to different churches in a parish on a rotating basis and the laity would cover for when the minister was not there. This has always been a part of the Methodism and we are getting back to our beginnings. **The Laity – YOU – are actually the hands, feet and voice of Christianity**. Were it not for the Peter, Andrew, John, Phillip, Thomas, Matthew, James, James the son of Alpheus, Batholomew, Simon, Simon, Paul, Matthais, and so many others, the Christian church and the Good News of Jesus Christ would not be known today.


Father's Day Sunday and Youth (Children's) Sunday

Wednesday Group Study subject stays the same starting at7pm but will end June 14th with a new study Book in September.




