#### From the Lay Delegates

"I, therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beg you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, <sup>2</sup> with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, <sup>3</sup> making every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace: <sup>4</sup> there is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling, <sup>5</sup> one Lord, one faith, one baptism, <sup>6</sup> one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all."

Pastor Choi, Mary Rolfe and I attended the New York Annual Conference last week. It is the first time the conference delegates have been able to meet in person since 2019. It was great to see everyone in person. This is a 2½ day conference of worship and business meetings. Since the Methodist tradition is connectional, it is necessary to meet to coordinate and plan upcoming ministries.

We voted on Trustees for the conference, next year's budget, mission programs, our apportionments are remaining the same. Apportionments is how we as a connectional church support other Methodist churches and also support our mission programs worldwide. The theme of the conference was "Stronger Together", and Bishop Bickerton shared the importance of moving forward as we come out of the pandemic and disaffiliation of some churches.

Our conference had 6 out of our 400+ churches vote to disaffiliate. Our church is waiting until the General conference of the United Methodist Church, which includes churches from 130 countries, meets next May and it is put in writing what exactly the changes will be regarding LGBTQ marriage and ordination of pastors before we as a church address this. 


