Kistorical Notes of First and Wesley

Did you know –

- This beautiful Church was dedicated on Sunday evening on November 26, 1916, with a recital of a cello, violin and organ. Rev J.W. Felvus was the first pastor, serving from 1868-71. At the time there were 41 members. Donations from the congregation were from \$5.00 to \$1,000.
- Twenty-two items were taken from the cornerstone of the old church and placed in our new facility with 9 more added.
- The Bishop Earl Cranston was in attendance for this special occasion.
- On Monday November 27th there was a reception for past ministers.
- They celebrated with special events until December 10th ending with George Jones, D.D. Board of Ministries, from New York.
- As an aside which I found very interesting
 - In 1900 population of town was 5,000
 - In 1910 population was 10,000
 - At the time of laying cornerstone population was 14,000

I hope you found this interesting - imagine the Methodists have been in West Haven for 155 years.
