Welcome, Pastor Frank and Nana!





News from the Trustees


The trustees held a clean up day in May where the landscaping was cleaned up and mulch laid. Thanks to Carmela Quinones, Shelby Poe, Laurie Simone, Judy Jennette and Pastor Choi for doing a wonderful job.

During the summer, we are asking anyone who stores anything in VBS room, gym, closets, etc. to take some time to sort through the items. Big trash pick up is in September and it is a good time to get rid of "stuff" we no longer use. Not only is it unsightly, it is probably a fire hazard. We did this a few years ago and it seems we have an abundance of "stuff" again.

We also are posting on Facebook market place that we have 3 oak pews that are free as long as they take them away. If anyone in the church would like to take a pew, let a trustee know. The short pews were in the back of the church (side aisles) and were removed years ago for the handicapped seating. The very long pew was removed recently for the A/V equipment to be moved back to allow for funerals, communion and other ceremonies at the altar.

We will be doing some more landscaping and striping the parking lot in June or September when it is cool. We have hired someone to mow the church lawn (Jim Stuhlman will continue to mow parsonage and take care of the shrubbery). 

After School Program Update

We will be ending this year's After School program on June 9th
We would like to thank all the people that have made this program possible and a success. Our two paid staff, Diana Grippen and Sheila Torres, and our <u>volunteers</u>:

Gail Bartozzi, Eileen Choi (youth helper), Pastor Choi, Serene Choi (youth helper), Cynthia Dodd, Jim Jerrell, Peggy Jerrell, Christine Latham, Audra Locke (youth helper), Abe McKim, Jeeyeon Park, Mary Rolfe, Laurie Simone, David Smith, Helen Smith, Kel Youngs.

We had between 12-19 children during the school year each day.

We have balance left of a few thousand dollars from the grant.

We reapplied for the grant but did not receive more funds, so a challenge we are facing is monetary. We are looking into other funding sources.

A second challenge is volunteers to help during the week. With Pastor Choi and his family moving, we are losing 4 volunteers. Pastor Frank is in favor of keeping this program running. To run the program, we need 3 (preferably 4) adult volunteers each day, in addition to the two paid staff, per day on a consistent basis. Please prayerfully consider if you can commit to one day per week - that would be very helpful! Thank you!

But nobody really wants to shirk.


